

**PETITIONERS' MOTION FOR THE IMMEDIATE
ISSUANCE OF A WRIT OF *HABEAS CORPUS* PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 2243
OR, ALTERNATIVELY, TO ISSUE AN ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Petitioners Hani Saleh Rashid Abdullah (“Petitioner Abdullah”) and Rami Bin Saad Al-Oteibi (“Petitioner Al-Oteibi”) (collectively “Detained Petitioners”), move the Court to issue forthwith, a writ of *habeas corpus*, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2243, returnable in three days, in order to proceed to a hearing on the merits of their Petition. Alternatively, Detained Petitioners seek the forthwith issuance of an order to show cause why a writ of *habeas corpus* should not be granted returnable in three days. In support thereof the court is referred to Petitioners' supporting memorandum of law.


