DEFINITIONS

2. “Force Resolution” means the Congressional declaration of September 14, 2001 stating

2(a) *** That the President is authorized to use all necessary and appropriate force against those nations, organizations, or persons he determines planned, authorized, committed, or aided the terrorist attacks that occurred on September 11, 2001, or harbored such organizations or persons, in order to prevent any future acts of international terrorism against the United States by such nations, organizations or persons.

3. “Document” includes all those materials described in Rule 34(a)(1).
4. “Petitioner” means Hani Saleh Rashid Abdullah, or any alias by which Mr.

Abdullah is known to you.

DOCUMENTS REQUESTED

1. All documents concerning Petitioner provided to you by the Government of Pakistan, its agencies, or instrumentalities.
2. All documents memorializing or describing any interrogation of Petitioner or any question you put to him.
3. All documents relating to any activity by Petitioner you believe to be conduct described in the Force Resolution.
4. Any document reflecting any statement made by or signed by Petitioner.
5. All documents concerning or relating to information obtained about Petitioner from any person in United States custody,
6. All documents referring or relating to any interrogation method or technique of interrogation applied to any person who provided information in documents called for by Request Number 5.
