The Department of Defense has made a final determination with respect to the attorney access procedures that will be imposed upon Mozzam Begg and Feroz Ali Abbasi. The Department of Defense has decided that no monitoring of counsel visits and communications pursuant to Sections IV and V of the "Procedures For Counsel Access to Detainees At the US Naval Base In Guantanamo Bay, Cuba" is required for counsel visits with Mr. Begg and Mr. Abbasi. All other requirements of the Procedures, including the need for counsel to obtain security clearances and the need for classification review of written material to ensure the proper handling of classified materials, as set forth in Sections VI and VII of the Procedures, will be imposed on counsel visits with Mr. Begg and Mr. Abbasi pending further notice.
