

MEMORANDUM FOR All Personnel Assigned to Joint Task Force GTMO

SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum #12, Air Bridge Operations

1. This memorandum prescribes the policy governing prohibited activities while conducting air bridge operations. It is applicable to all military and civilian personnel that are either assigned to or performing duties at Joint Task Force GTMO.
2. Prohibited Activities: Purchase, possession, use, sale or transfer of weapons, ammunitions, or explosives at any time while conducting military operations, to include all other operations while outside the area of operations.
3. The JTF-GTMO General Order #1 and JTF-GTMO Policy Memorandum applies at all times while conducting military operations, to include all operations while outside the area of operations.
4. Punitive Order: This order is punitive. Persons subject to the UCMJ who violate this order may be punished under Article 92, UCMJ for violating a lawful general order; or receive adverse administrative actions or both. Civilians serving with, employed by, or accompanying the U.S. Armed Forces in JTF-GTMO may face adverse administrative actions for violation of this order.
